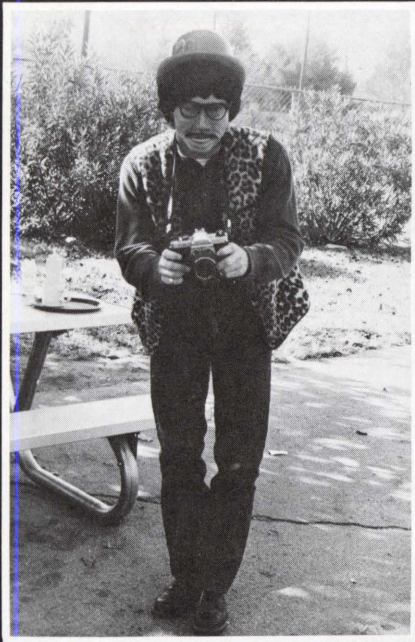
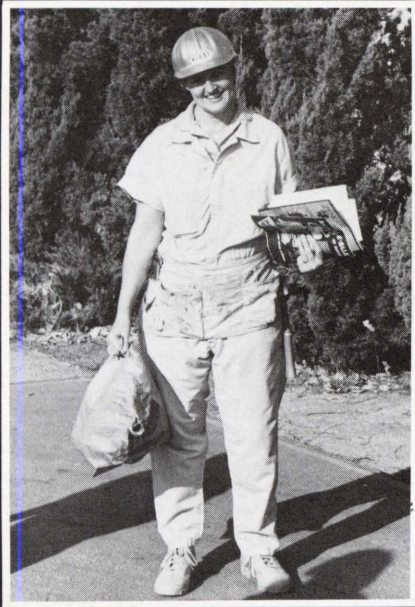




Dr. Judith Webber, Principal

My wish on a star would be: For everyone to enjoy all of the spiritual, moral, mental and physical qualities that the term "good health" implies.

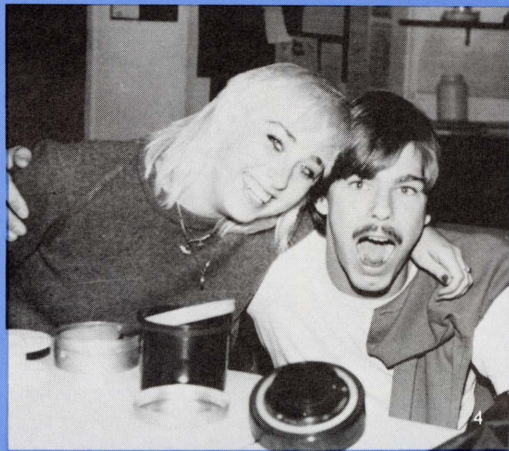
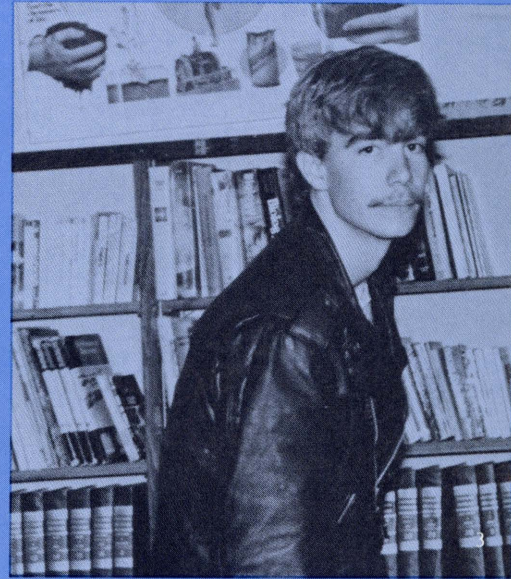
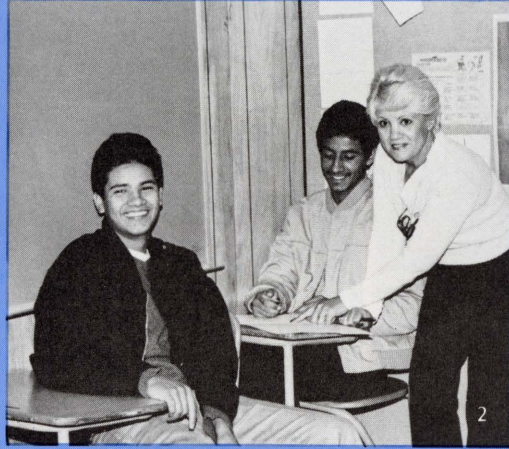
