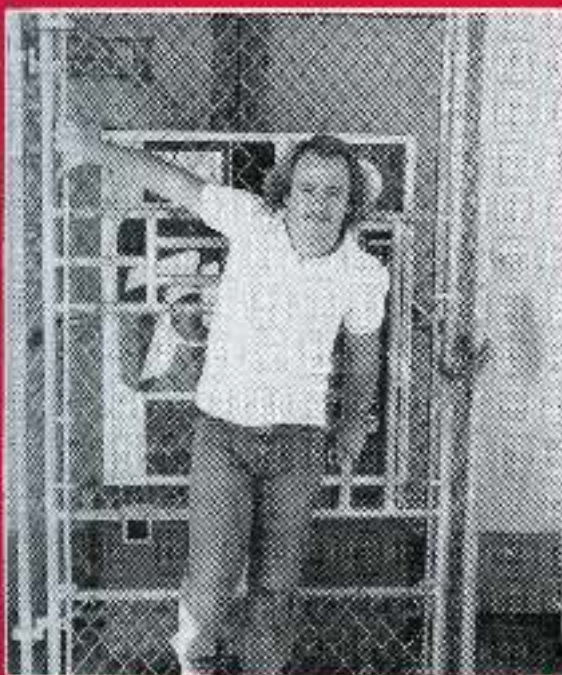
*Melody Holt - 16*

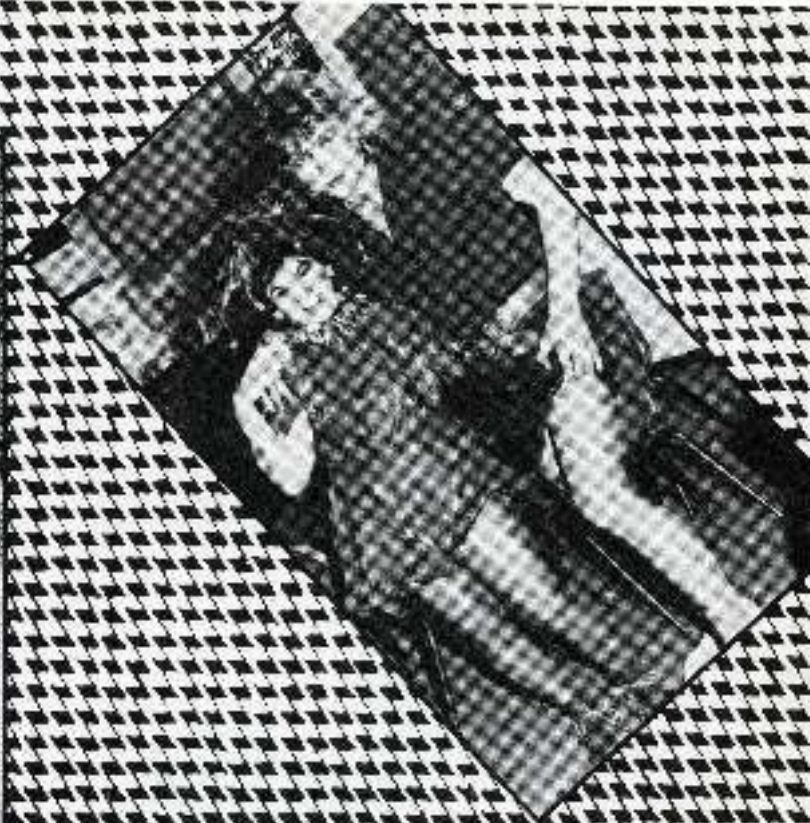


# Halloweenies

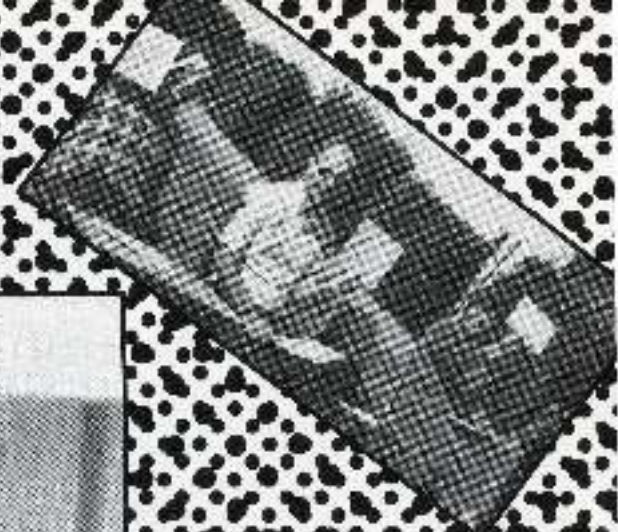


## Wahoo! Yat!

## Treatment For Adolescent Chemical Dependency

A Growing Problem...

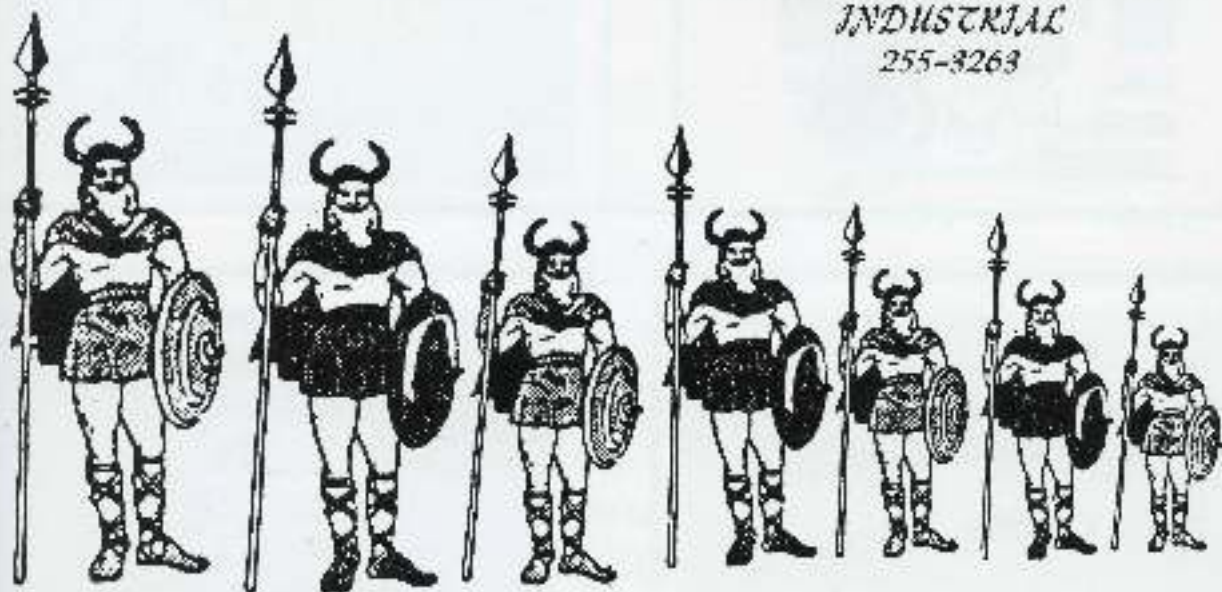
