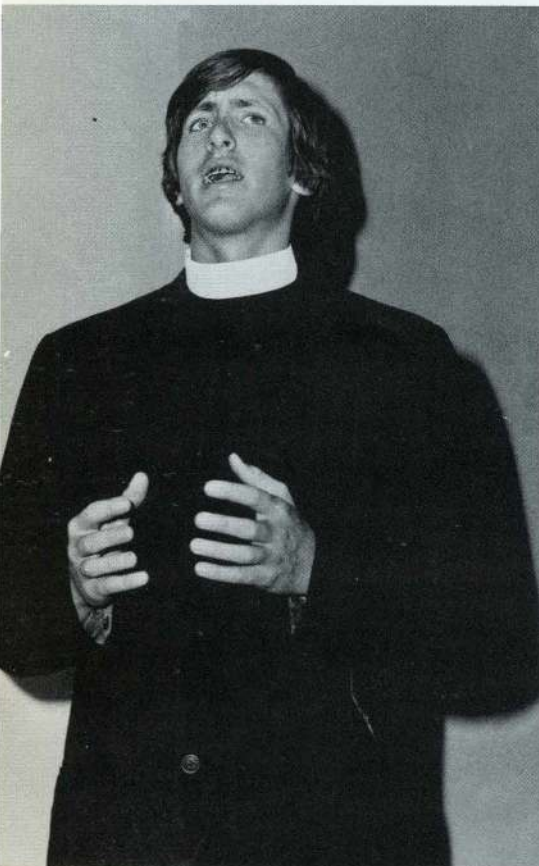

## Canyon's Annual 'Back to School Nite'

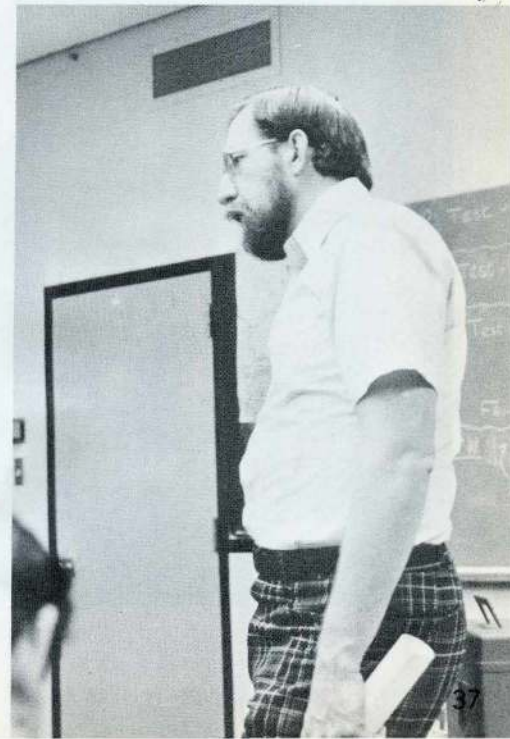
Canyon High hosted it's annual 'Back to School' night on the 13th of October

G.I.A. officers for next year were inducted along with the presentation of the Athlete of the Year award given to Sandra Harris.

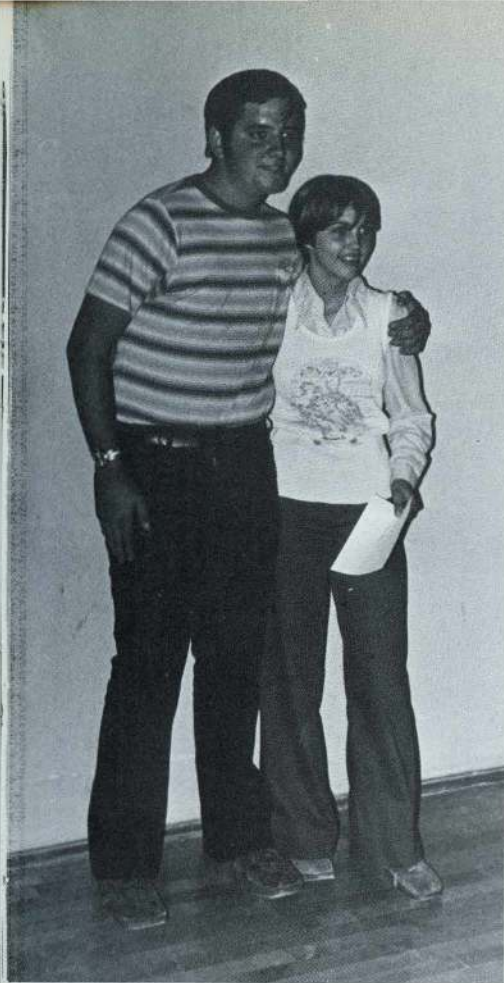

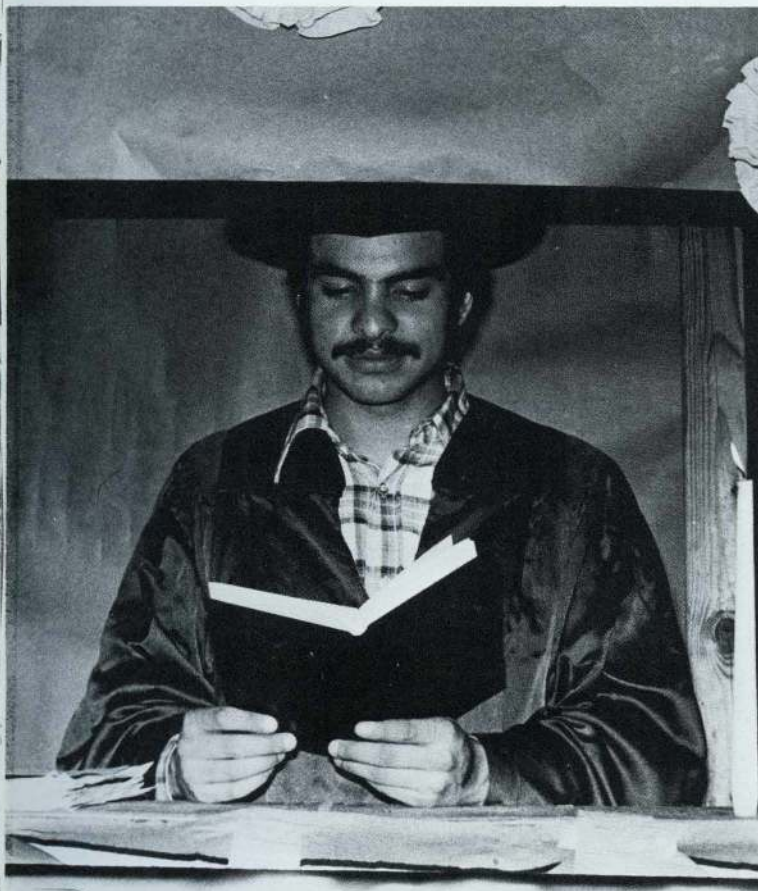

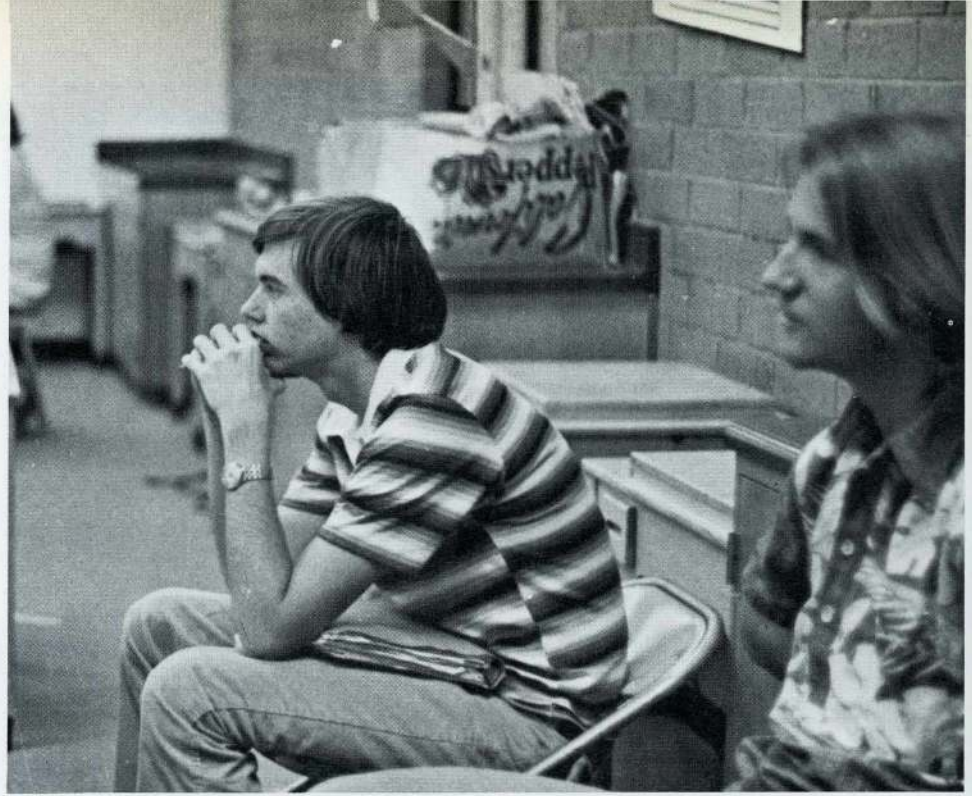

# Work Experience

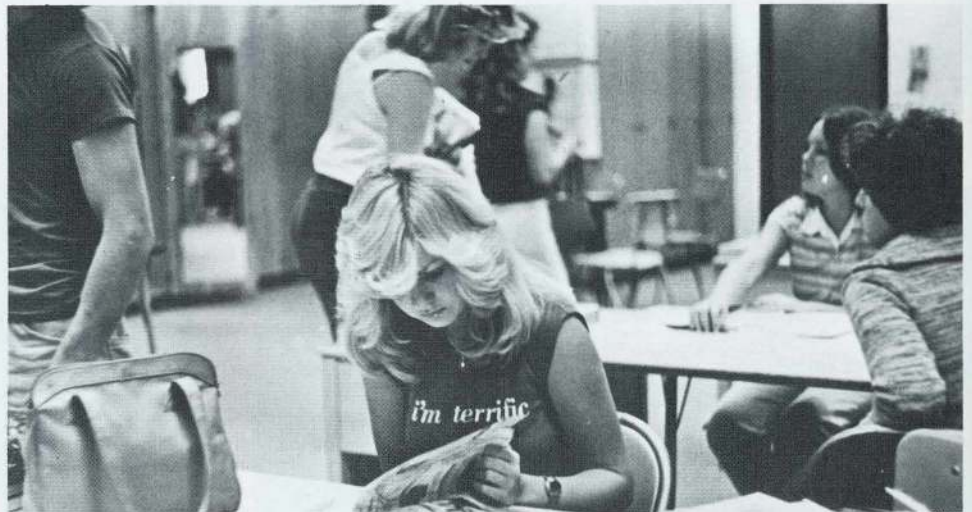

Data from experiments was entered into this computer and answers to mathematical problems were printed onto a computer readout. The purpose of this trip was to familiarize students with plants and animals of this area. Also, Mr. Hurd's Physics field trip to Big Bear. In Big Bear Physics students pointed out stars, planets, and constellations for bonus points.

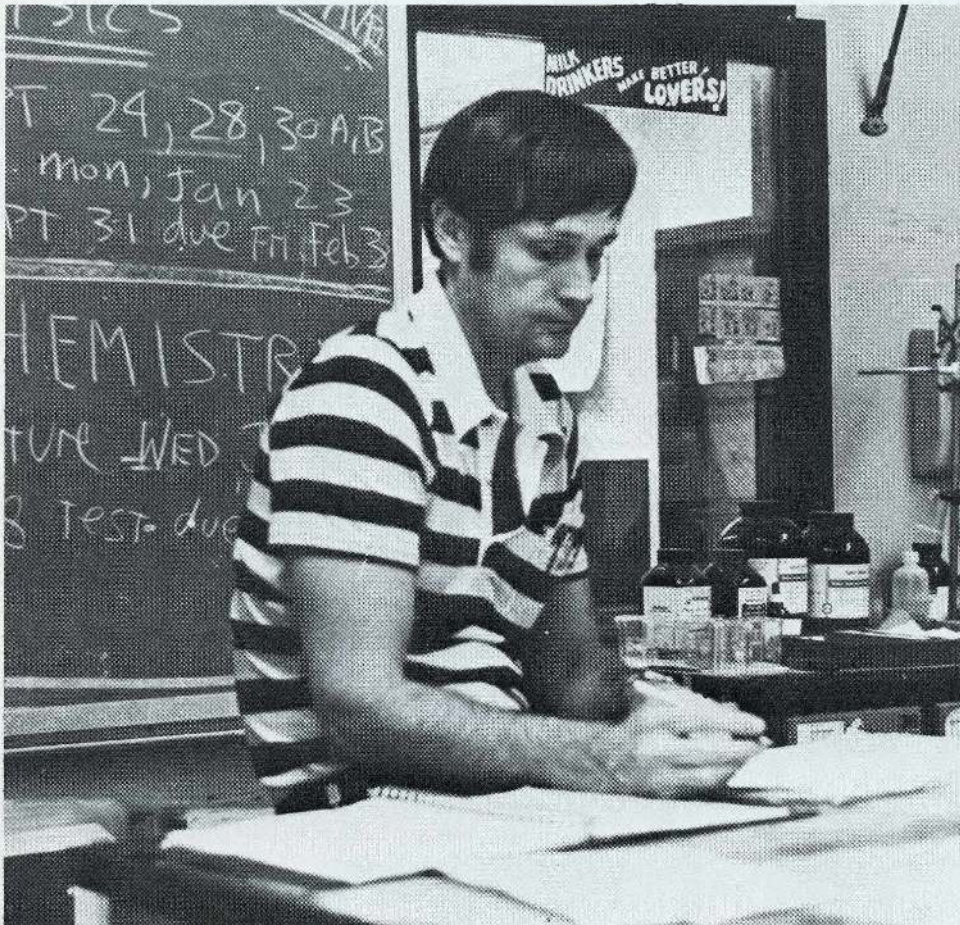

# Math Introduces New Program

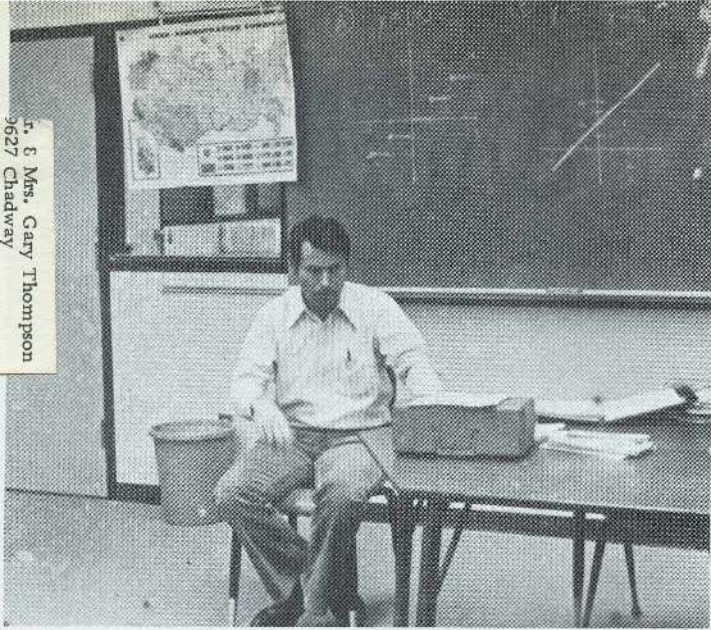
The math department has proven to be more than effective. In the 1977 school year, the school's median score for the Scholastic Aptitude Test on the math section was 493. The national median for the same year was 470.

Last year a new program was put into effect, the math lab. In the math lab students used an adding machine, computer, and cassette tapes to help them overcome these difficulties. As Ms. Johnson stated, "It's small, but it's a beginning."

The department offered a variety of classes last year. As usual, the Individualized Math Program (basic mathematics) was offered. In the college preparatory program, Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Trigonometry, Probability and Statistics, Math Analysis, and Calculus were offered.



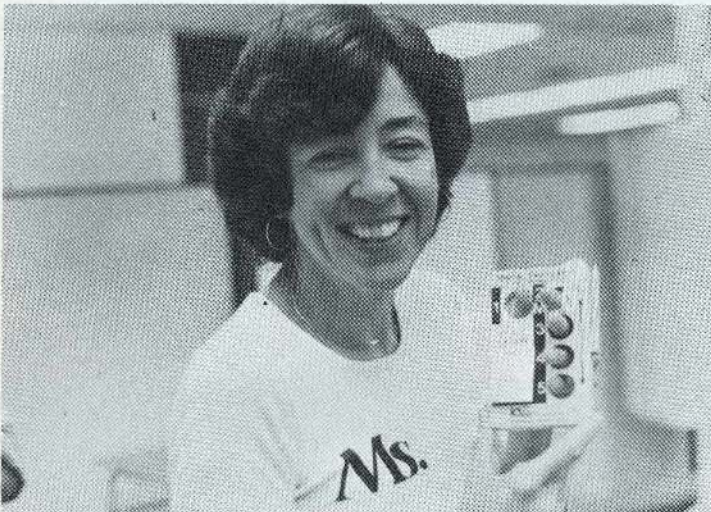

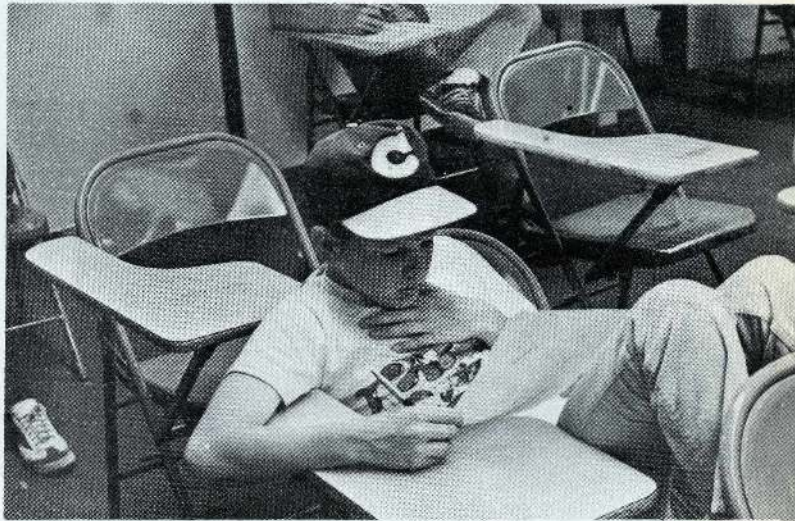

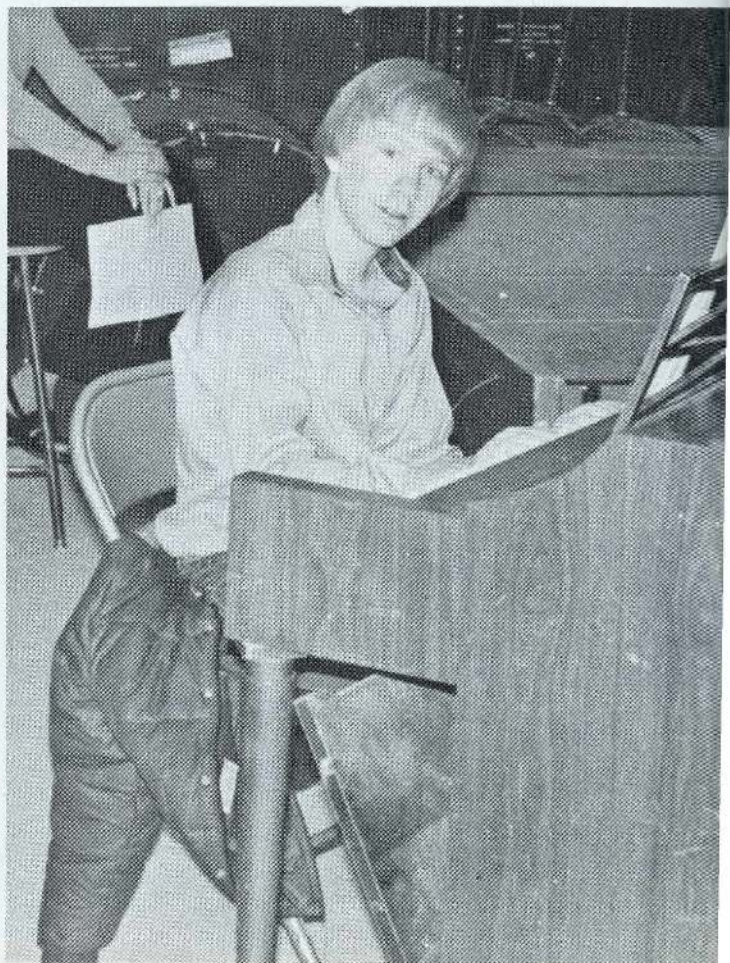

## Fine Arts

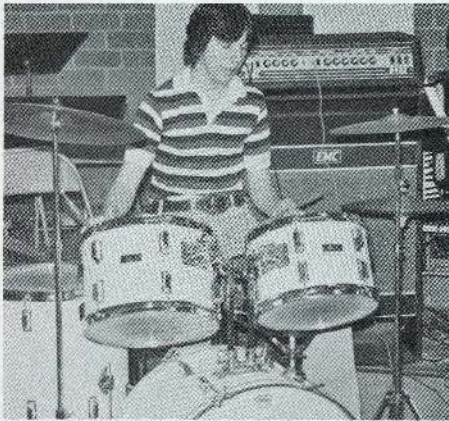

The classes offered by the Fine Arts Department were Band, Art 2-D and 3-D, Chorus, Drama and Photo Journalism.

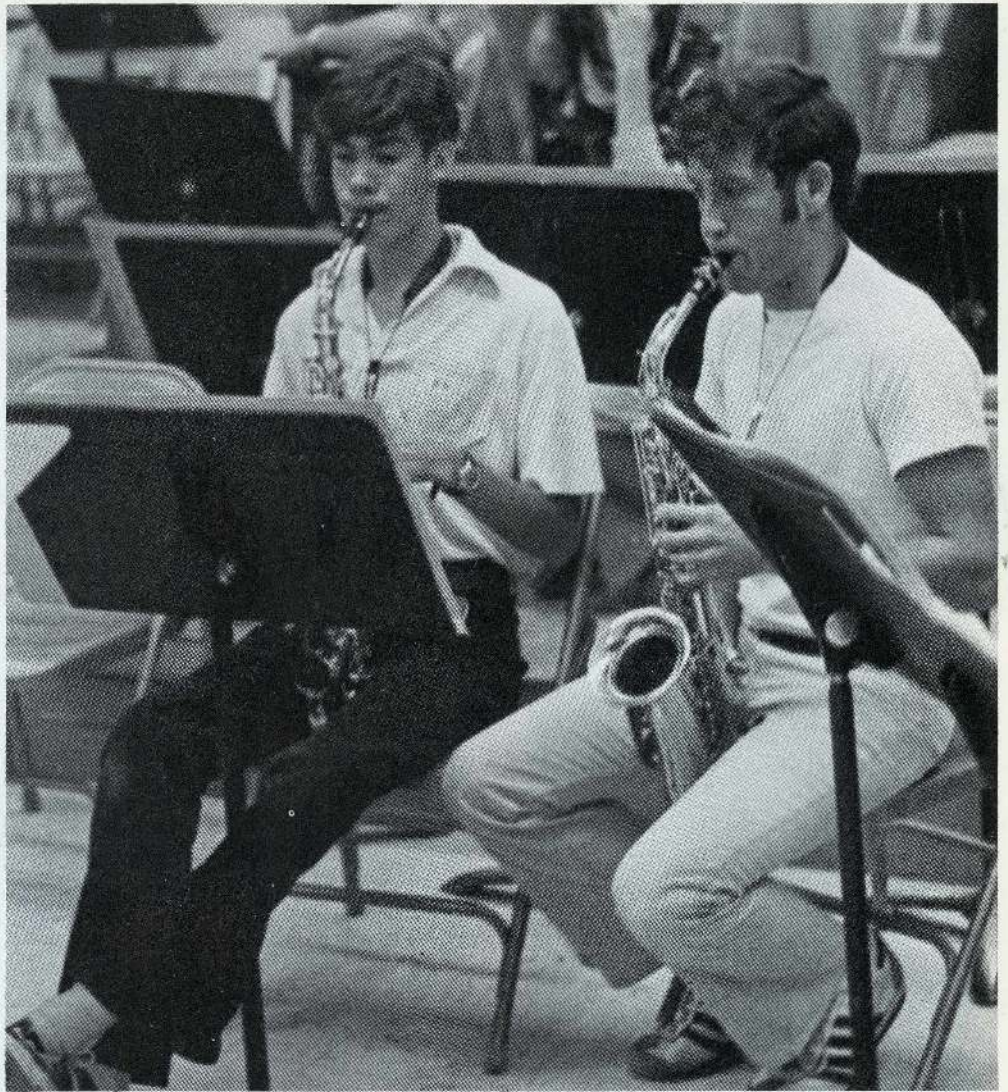

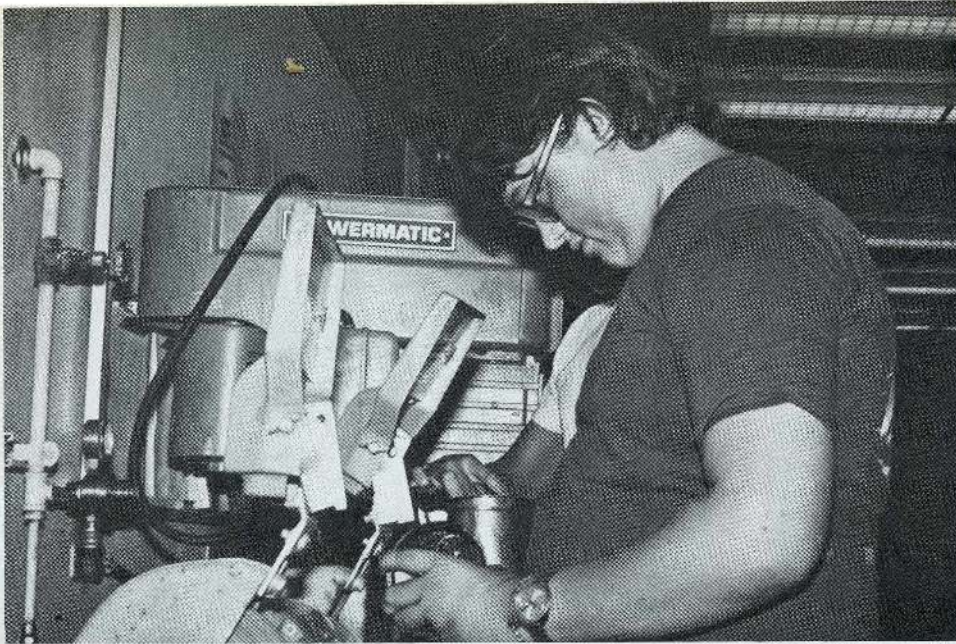
Last year, the Industrial Arts Department acquired new photo processing equipment. This equipment enabled students of the photography classes to develop color negatives and print color pictures.

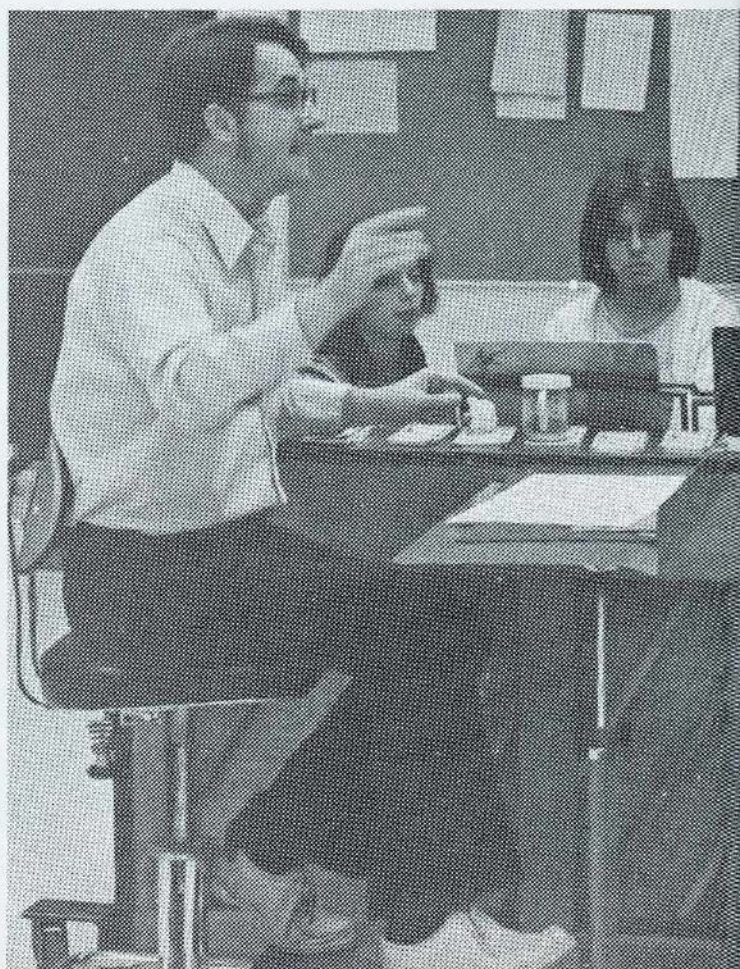


# Voice of Canyon

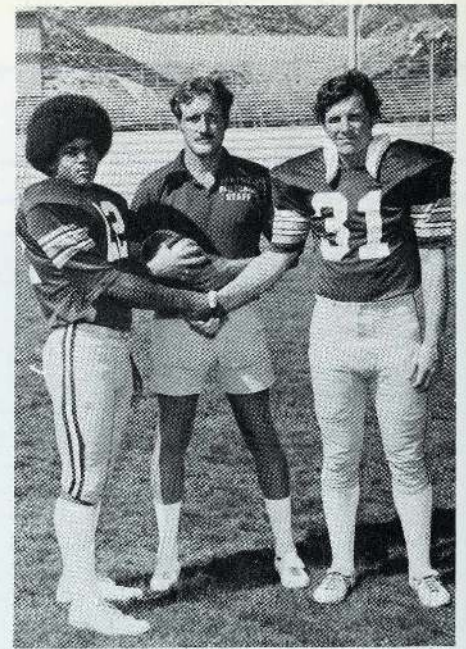
# Varsity Joins Golden League

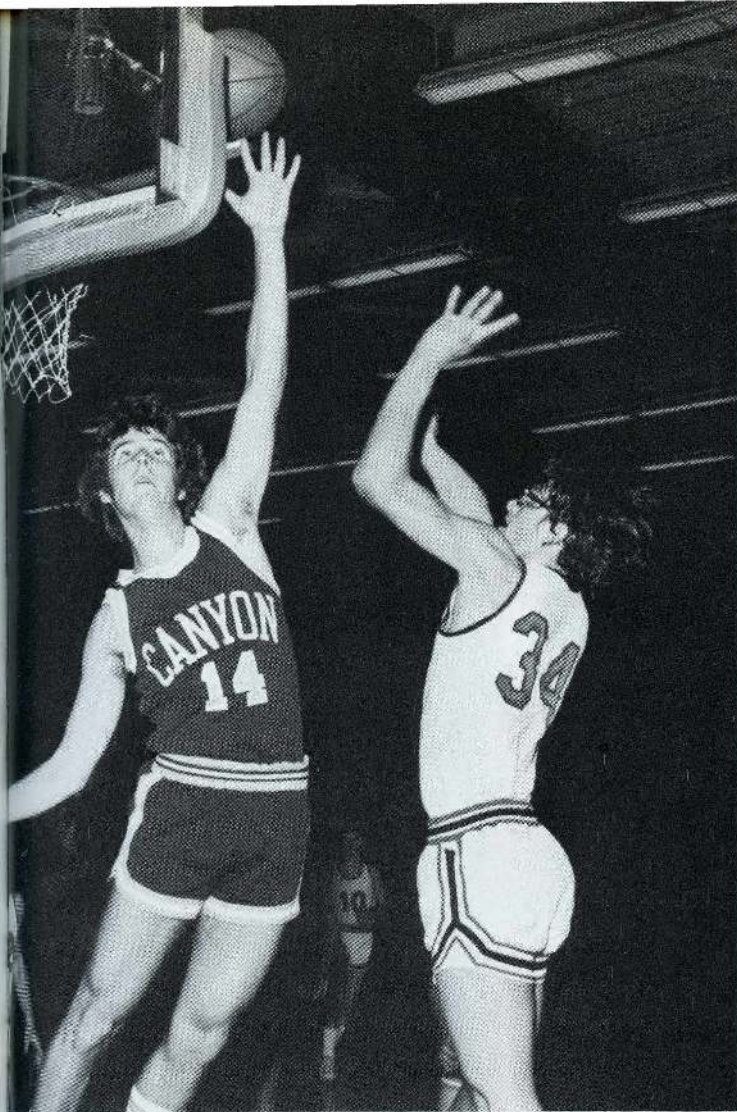
# J.V. Basketball Takes Second

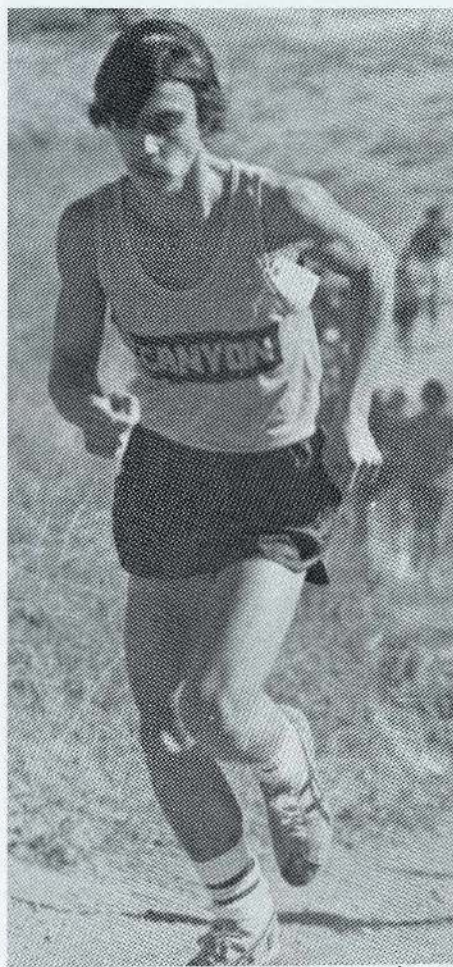
## Cross Country Team Splits

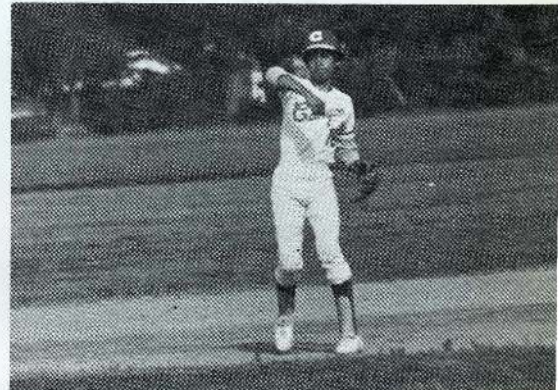
## Frosh Baseball Shoots for the Top

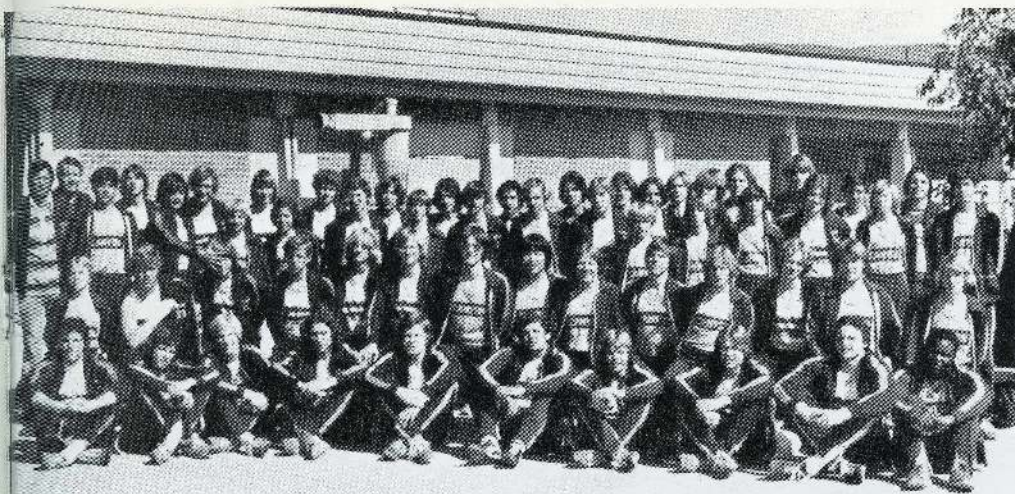
# Track

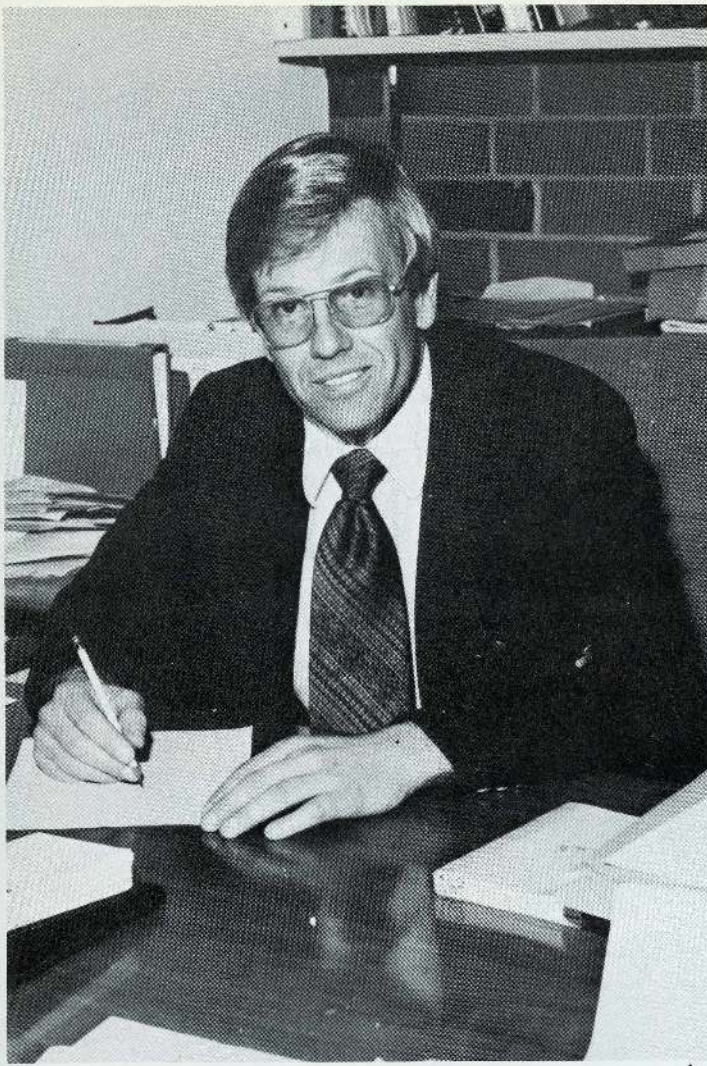
# Our Management Team

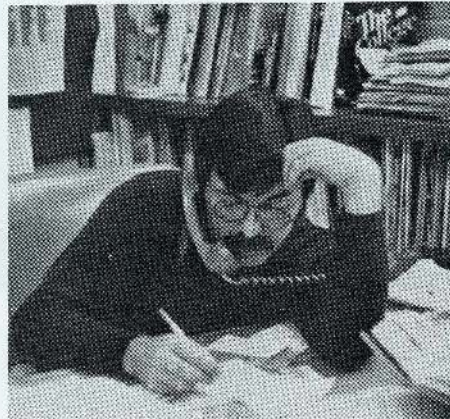
# Counselors Work Under Heavy Load

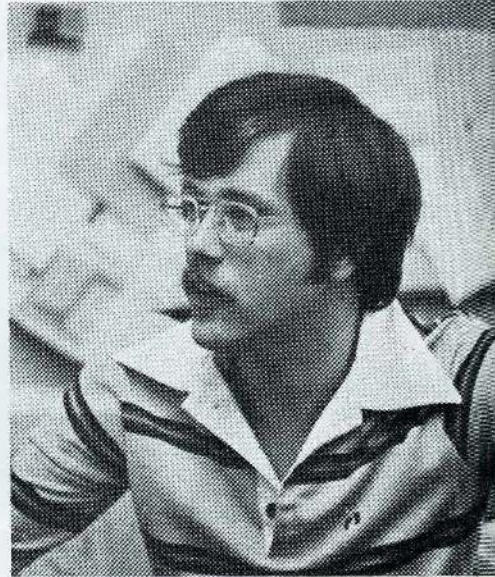

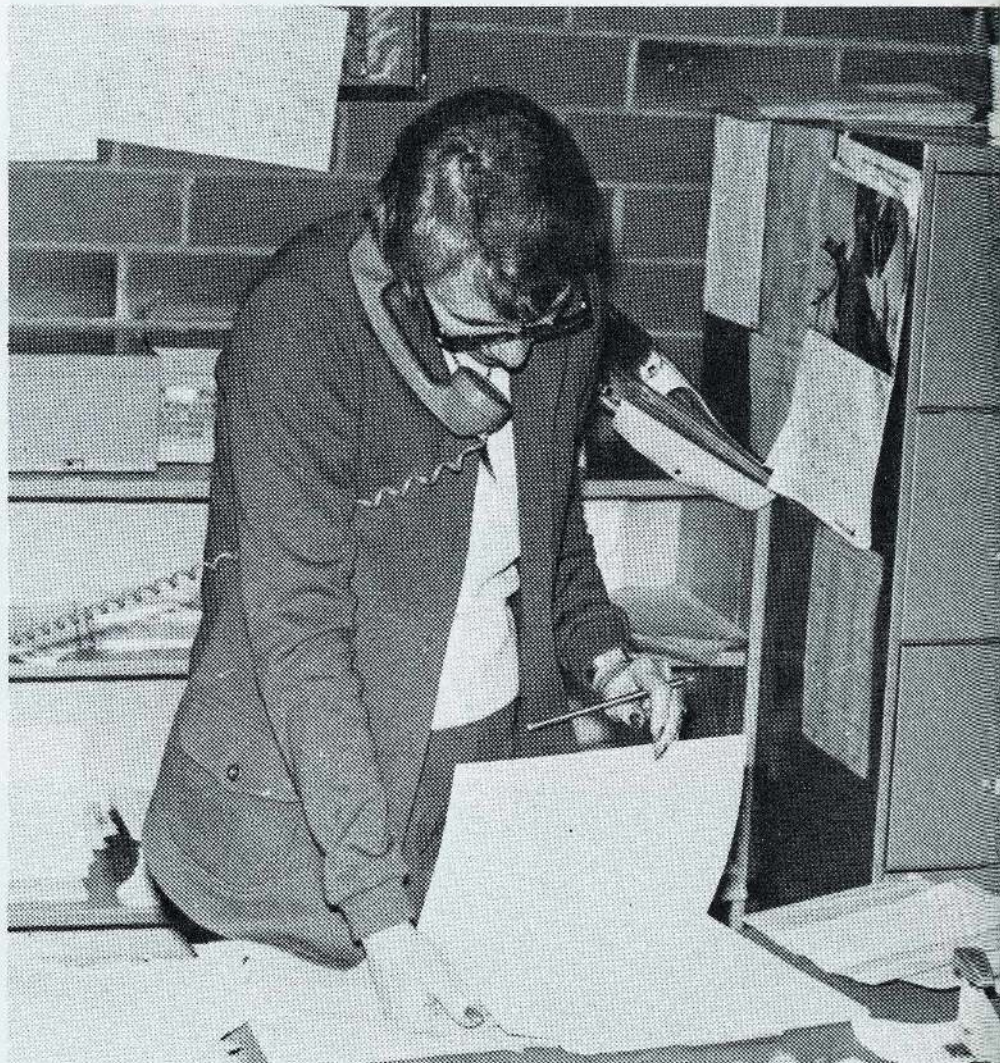
# Aids
