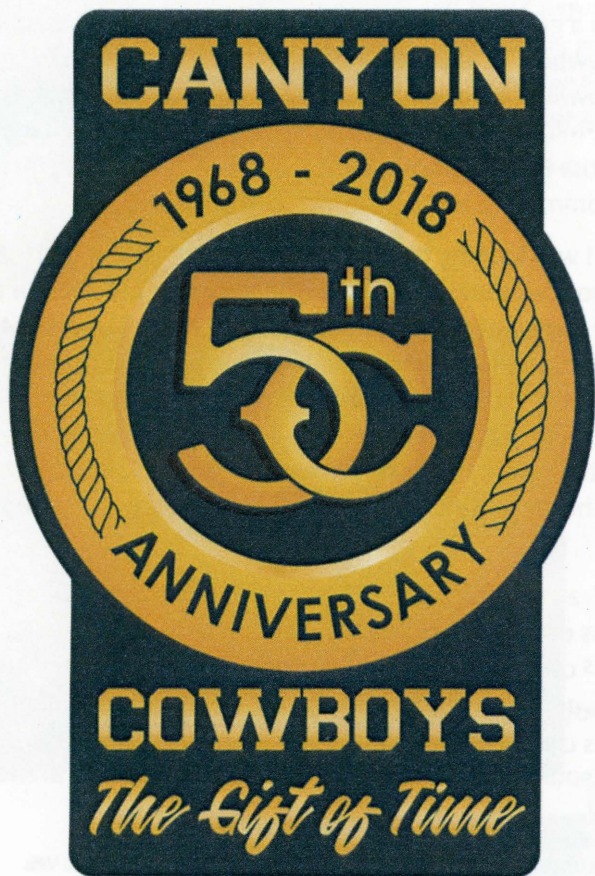

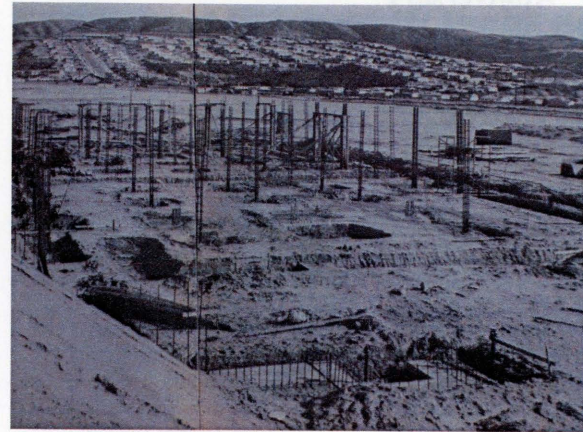

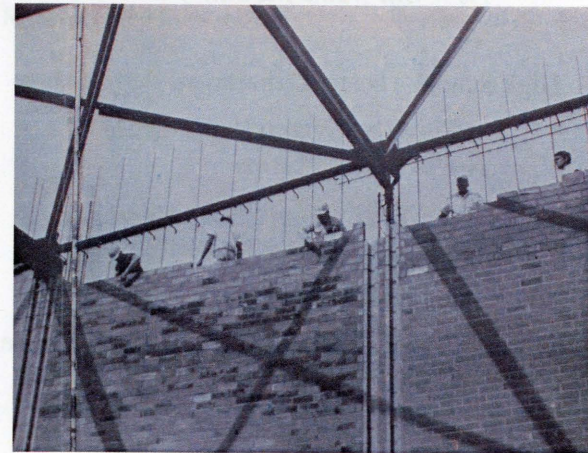
I hope you enjoy this evening's celebration. As it was 50 years ago and will be 50 years from today, it's great to be a Cowboy!

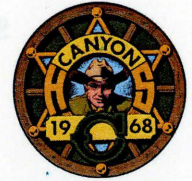

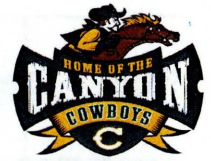

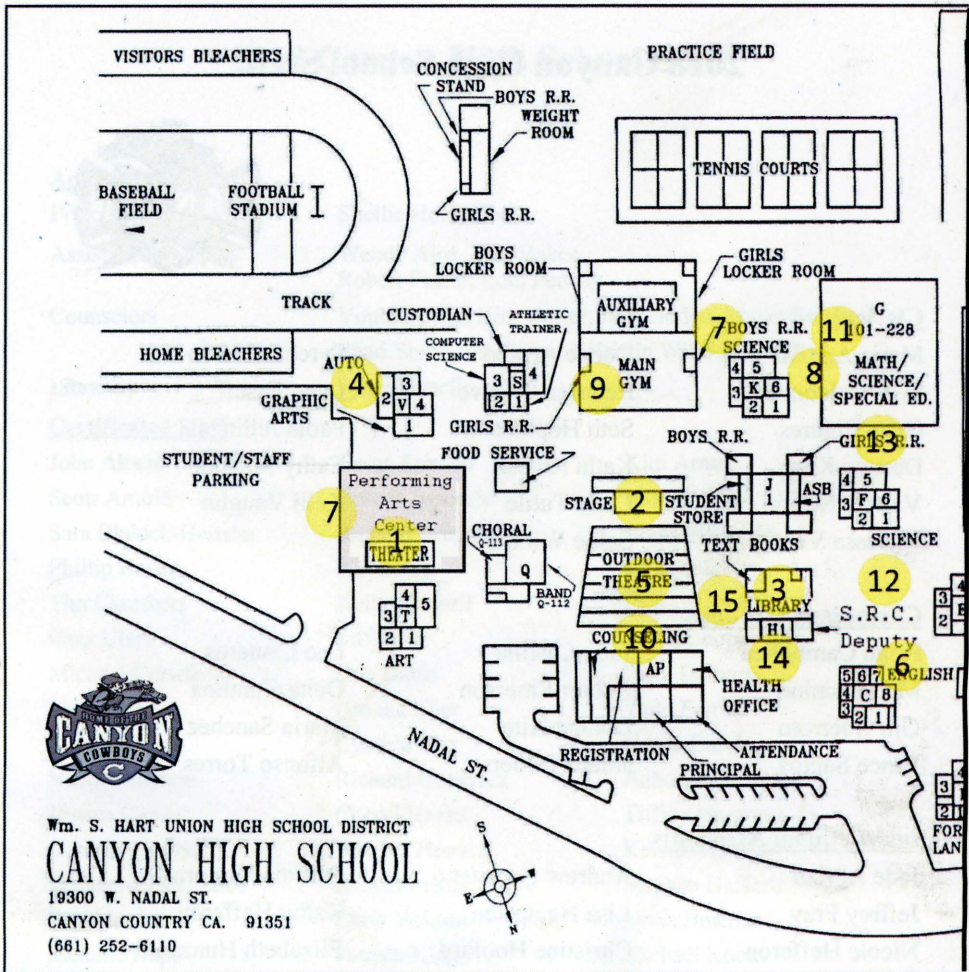
