



FINANCIALLY SPEAKING

The fees established for participating in NSAC programs are minimal compared to many others in the Valley. We attempt to maintain low fees to attract as many boys and girls as possible. These fees in no way cover the cost of the football program, which averages \$110.00 per boy. Therefore, to supplement the players fees and to offset charging \$90.00 to \$120.00 per boy we must conduct fund raising programs such as raffles, candy sales and other events such as advertising in this yearbook. We were fortunate this year to receive a \$250.00 donation from Union Home Loans. This helps to provide for those who are unable to pay the full fees, and is greatly appreciated. Interested business support is a welcome assist to our program.

In this book you will find a breakdown of our investment per boy for football, basketball and track. This should help you to recognize the continuing need for funds. \$40,000 was budgeted for the 1973 programs. This is less than 1972, however a considerable amount of equipment was purchased last year, part of which had to be paid for this year. At this point it is safe to say that the 1973 football program will be self-supporting, reaching the same success that our Basketball and Track programs have experienced over the years.

New methods of financing are being pursued and hopefully we will be successful. In the meantime we must continue our present fund raising activities.

N.S.A.C. FOOTBALL

The 1973 Football program is off to a great start with 360 players and 110 cheerleaders participating. Seven teams, Gremlins thru Bantams, competing in Valley Conference Leagues and five Mitey Mite teams round out our local Farm League program. League play began on September 15 following 6 weeks of workouts and scrimmages which started on August 1.

In preparation for this year's program a series of successful coaches' clinics were held beginning last March. Emphasis was on basics, uniformity and continuity in our football program. The local high school coaches are to be commended for the help they offered during the clinics.

This season promises to be a great season; a lot of games will be won by our teams competing in the Valley Conference and sportsmanship and teamwork will be emphasized for everyone.
