

The Boys' Club of Newhall-Saugus is a chartered member of Boys' Club of America and is headquartered in Newhall. Besides out main clubhouse, we maintain four satellite quarters in Saugus and Valencia at Valley View School, Skyblue Mesa School, Emblem School and St. Stephen's Episcopal Church.

The purpose of our club is to provide after-school recreation, education, skills and guidance to all youngsters in the communities of Newhall, Saugus, Valencia and Castaic.






Our club is considered "a model" by Boys' Club of America and by the United Way Agency. We were one of the initiators of the "Outreach Program" to extend our services to hitherto inaccessible suburban areas. We were also one of the first Boys' Clubs to admit girls, who presently comprise 30% of our membership. Our five club centers combined serve an incredible 225 children each day, and their facilities are used by over 1,200 different youngsters during the year. Our plans for the future include further expansion to other outlying areas with our own mobile club-houses.

For our operations, we are funded by the local United Way Agency, by contributions from private citizens and by fund-raisers such as this auction.

For this evening, the order of events and the rules will be approximately the same as in 1972. There will be plenty of pretty girls and enough champagne, appetizers and spirits to please all.



Mr. Jerry Holland of Newhall has again consented to do the auctioning this evening. An intrepid traveler, Mr. Holland has interrupted his cross-country vacation and has flown 2,000 miles just to be here with us this evening.

Known as one of the best "voices" in the Santa Clarita Valley, Jerry has more than 20 years of professional auctioning experience behind him. He is presently employed with the Southern California Automobile Auction Company.

BIDDING FOR THE PRIZES

On entering the gallery on auction evening, you will be issued a bid card with a bid number assigned. This number is required for all bidding and purchasing of items at the auction, so please memorize it and keep your card with you.

The auction will begin promptly at 9 p.m. Please take your seats before the auction begins.

THE GRAND LIST OF PRIZES

There are 50 items on the "Grand List" in this catalogue. They will be supplemented by approximately 10 more on the evening of the auction. All of these will be called by the auctioneer in the order that they appear in this catalogue. During the bidding, use your bid cards to attract the spotters' or the auctioneer's attention. If you win an item, please announce your bid number when requested by the auctioneer. Prizes will be awarded to the highest bidder.

THE SILENT AUCTION

Listed at the end of this catalogue are additional items that will be offered in the "Silent Auction" — on bid boards posted along the sides of the gallery. There will be three boards, closing at different intervals during the evening.

A bid sheet will be attached to each prize, and bidding will be done by writing your name, bid number and amount of bid on the highest open line — if you are willing to pay more than the previous bid. Five minutes after each board closes, the results will be announced by the auctioneer, and winning bidders may make payments and claim prizes at the cashier's table.

PAYING FOR THE PRIZES

It is requested that all prizes be paid for in full at the auction. During the auctioning of the grand prizes, should you win a prize, simply announce your bid number and keep your seat. A runner will bring an invoice directly to you, at which time you should make payment. Both cash and checks are acceptable and you shall receive a written receipt.

If necessary, payment of prizes may be deferred until June 30, 1973, but each prize will require a minimum deposit of \$20 or 20%, whichever is more. Such prizes will be held by the Boys' Club until payment is remitted in full. Deposits are not refundable.

For persons unable to participate in this evening's ceremonies, bids may be submitted in advance by mailing them to "Boys' Club Auction", P.O. Box 822, Newhall, California 91321. The Boys' Club will honor all bids received by midnight, Friday, June 8, 1973. A deposit of \$20 or 20%, whichever is more, must accompany all mail bids. Mail deposits are refundable.

TAX DEDUCTIBILITY

The Newhall-Saugus Boys' Club is a non-profit organization. Therefore, the amount paid for a prize in excess of its value is tax-deductible. Written receipts indicating such an amount for tax purposes will be issued to you after the auction at your request. The values set forth opposite some of the items on the grand list are estimates only, and should not be used for tax purposes.

EXPIRATION DATES

Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be used within one year from June 9, 1973.

Getting to the Auction:




California Institute of the Arts is located at the McBean Parkway exit of the Golden State Freeway (Highway 5) in Valencia.
