

The Boys' and Girls' Club is a youth guidance organization providing meaningful activity and character building programs for youngsters in the Santa Clarita Valley. Founded in 1968, it is part of a national network of organizations affiliated with the Boys' Clubs of America.


The most inclusive club in the valley, the Boys' and Girls' Club provides daily activities at 6 different program sites. Conveniently located on school grounds, the club is within easy walking distance for a large number of children. The well-rounded program includes Social Recreation, Co-ed Sports Leagues, Arts & Crafts and Special Events. Frequent trips and campouts are planned for weekends. The program operates during after-school and evening hours when youngsters are best able to attend.

The Boys' and Girls' Club employs a professional staff who are trained in the Boys' Club philosophy of providing informal guidance through individual and small group experiences. By recognizing and responding to the restless energies, curiosity, and youthful quest for "something to do", the Boys' and Girls' Club gives youngsters a chance to improve their lives by allowing them to develop values and skills during critical periods of growth. All yongsters can benefit by the programs provided by the Club. Perhaps those who benefit most are children residing in families where there is only one parent.

The generous support of our community continues to provide the incentive for the Club's first permanent Clubhouse opened at Emblem School. The culmination of 5 years of planning, the facility has become the showcase for youth programming in the Santa Clarita Valley. In November of 1981 construction began on the Club's second permanent clubhouse, located on the campus of Sierra Vista Junior High School in Canyon Country. Similar in nature to the facility at Emblem, the ultramodern structure will double the capacity to serve the youngsters of this area.

From its inception the Boys' and Girls' Club has responded to growing needs for youth services through planned expansion and program development. Your continued support has brightened the dreams and hopes of thousands of youngsters.

The Auction will be divided into two parts: **THE LIVE AUCTION** will feature verbal bidding on items 801-850 in full color in the middle of the catalogue.

THE SILENT AUCTION will feature written bidding for auction items 101-740 and 901-1410. Bid Boards are posted on the walls of the main gallery. We respectfully request that you you read THE RULES OF THE AUCTION listed in the catalogue.



The Rules of the Auction

Live Auction

- The Live Auction will begin at 8:30 p.m. and will run to approximately 11:00 p.m. It will consist of the voice auctioning of Items 801 through 851 in the order they appear in this catalogue and in the addendum.
- 2. All bidding at the auction will require a bid number. Your personal bid number is located on the back of your catalogue along with your registration certificate. Fill out your registration card in advance to avoid congestion at the entrance on the auction evening. A bid card is required for all bidding and purchasing of items.
- 3. During the live auction, when you want to bid on an item, wave your pom-pom as frantically as possible to attract the auctioneer's or spotter's attention. If you win an item, immediately announce your bid number to the auctioneer or spotter and remain in your seat.
- 4. A "runner" will bring a sales slip directly to you, indicating the prize you have purchased and the amount of your winning bid. You may wait until the end of the evening and pay for all your purchases at one time at the cash table.
- 5. All goods (not services) are subject to the 6½% California sales tax which will be added to the amount of your purchase.

Silent Auction

The silent auction will begin at 6:00 p.m. and will consist of written bidding on approximately 500 items posted on the bid boards along the walls. 13 groups of bid board items are listed in this catalogue. Additional items will be added to group 14 and will be listed in the addendum, published just before the auction. The Live Auction group is 800.

2. **Each item** can be located according to its group number. Bids will be accepted on each item until the board closes. The following are the closing times:

- 3, All items in the silent auction have bid sheets attached or affixed nearby. Persons desiring to bid must do so legibly, writing their name, bid card number, and the amount of the bid on the bid sheet. Any bid without a bid card number will be automatically disqualified.
- 4. **Each bid sheet** notes a **minimum value** by which the existing bid must be increased in order to constitute a higher valid bid. Each new bid must be written on the **uppermost blank line** available on the bid sheet.
- 5. All bids must be in even dollar amounts (no cents). Any bid which includes cents will be automatically disqualified.
- 6. The bid boards will be closed approximately at the times stated here in the catalogue. However, the official closing will be that time when the Boys' & Girls' Club Official actu-

ally removes the bid sheet from the board.

- 7. **In the event** that bidding is still in progress when the Boys' & Girls' Club Official attempts to close the board, the Official shall conduct a **mini-live auction** on the spot allowing all persons wishing to bid to do so and shall determine the winning bidder, subject to rule 8 below.
- 8. After the bid board is closed, the bid sheets will be taken to the item verification table. At this time, the validity of all bids will be verified (bid number, even dollar bids, minimum increase, etc). The highest valid bid will be declared the winner and the decision of the official will be final. Shortly after the board is closed, an official shall post the bid number of the winning bidder on the board.

General Rules

- 1. The Boys' & Girls' Club requires that all prizes be paid for in full at the auction. Payment may be made by cash, check, BankAmericard, VISA, or MasterCard.
- 2. Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be used within one year from June 11, 1983. Unless otherwise specified or stated by donor, all items are transferrable from the winner to another person.
- 3. According to the Internal Revenue Service, only the amount paid for an auction prize "in excess of the actual cash value of that prize" is tax deductible. A written receipt indicating such an amount for tax purposes will be issued to you after the auction at your request.
- 4. **All sales are final.** However, the Boys' & Girls' Club will refund the full purchase price of any item where there is a failure of performance either on the part of the Boys' & Girls' Club or on the part of the donor.
- 5. All winning bidders are to report to the cashier's table to pay for the items and to claim their prizes. Any bidder not making arrangements for payment at the cashier's table by 12:30 a.m. may, at the discretion of the Boys' & Girls' Club, forfeit his right to purchase the item and it will be made available to the next highest bidder.
- 6. All items should be removed from the premises on the night of the auction. In the event you cannot remove your purchases that evening then you must do so between 12 noon and 5 p.m. on Sunday June 12, 1983. If you wish to do otherwise, prior arrangements must be made by either the purchaser or donor.

A special addendum to be published and given to each guest at the auction will list an additional group of bid board items. The addendum will also list all corrections and deletions necessary for any item published in this catalogue.
